Linton Greenway Active Travel Path – Addenbrooke’s to Worts’ Causeway

The Greater Cambridge Partnership and contractors Milestone Infrastructure are currently working to improve the Worts’ Causeway/A1307 junction and install new traffic lights. The works are progressing well and on schedule to be completed in early September.

The current closure of the Worts’ Causeway junction will be lifted from Monday, 6 September and replaced by temporary traffic lights, whilst the traffic signal installation is completed.

Resurfacing works – road closure and diversion route

From Wednesday, 8 September the A1307 will be resurfaced from the Worts’ Causeway junction to the Addenbrooke’s Roundabout.

The A1307 will be closed between Addenbrooke’s Roundabout and Granham’s Road overnight (8pm to 6am) for four weekday nights.

The closure is required to enable the resurfacing to be carried out efficiently, whilst an overnight closure minimises disruption to traffic.

Access to properties, for emergency services, buses and active travel path users will be maintained at all times.

An official diversion route will be signposted via A1307 – A11 – A505 – A1301 Sawston to Great Shelford – Trumpington – A1134 Long Road

We do apologise for any inconvenience these works and closures may cause. We are working closely with our contractors to minimise disruption.

Next steps

Once the resurfacing works are completed, the new traffic signals at the Worts’ Causeway junction will be commissioned and the temporary traffic signals removed. This part of the work is scheduled for week commencing the 13 September.

The Linton Greenway improvement work will then move on along the A1307 towards Addenbrooke’s, before continuing towards Granham’s Road junction. This part of the works is scheduled to be completed by the end of November.

These works will be carried out under local, temporary traffic management to allow a safe route for active travel path users.
