| Details of decision taken  | <p>After a review of the details of the proposed scheme and taking into account the written representation received, the Service Director of the Greater Cambridge Partnership, in conjunction with Councillor Peter McDonald, decided that the proposals should be implemented as published.</p> <p>The objectors and others who submitted written representations will be informed of the outcome accordingly.</p>   |
| Reasons for taking decision  | Objections were raised to the 20mph speed limit through the village. The 20mph limit was requested by Shepreth Parish Council and residents to improve safety in the village. The Parish Council has collated evidence showing the number of speeding vehicles in the village during community speed checks. 20mph speed limits have been shown to improve road safety at a number of locations. Alongside PR1102, speeds should be reduced through the village. |
