Title of decision	PR1106 Traffic Regulation Order objections associated with proposed 20mph speed limit on Station Road, Meldreth.
Date decision taken	30 January 2026

Details of decision taken	After a review of the details of the proposed scheme and taking into account the written representation received, the Interim Director of GCP, in conjunction with Councillor Bostanci, decided that the proposals should be implemented as published. The objectors and others who submitted written representations will be informed of the outcome accordingly.
Reasons for taking decision	A single objection was raised, which sought information on the business case and rational for the 20mph limit. An outline business case for the route has been agreed by the Greater Cambridge Partnership Executive Board and evidence shows (through Crash Map) that there have been five accidents, including one serious accident, on Station Road over the last 5 years. A lower speed limit will improve road safety and support active travel.
