Decision taken by an officer of the Council

Title of decision	PR1095 Replace existing parking bays on Church Street, Stapleford; which provided parking for 30 minutes between 8am and 6pm with a new restriction prohibiting waiting on Monday-Friday between 8am-9am & 3pm-4pm. Free parking will still be provided within the bay between 9am-3pm with a maximum stay of 30 minutes. Install a no waiting at any time restriction, on the south side of London Road, Stapleford, at a point approximately 37 metres south-east of its junction with Church Street in a south easterly direction for approximately 18 metres.

Details of decision taken	After a review of the details of the proposed scheme, the Interim Director of GCP, in conjunction with Councillors Damary-Homan and Fane, decided that the proposals should be implemented as published. The objector will be informed of the outcome accordingly.
Reasons for taking decision	One response was received to the TRO Church St parking proposal, which related to exiting HGVs from nearby business posing a danger to cyclists and pedestrians. Double Yellow Lines and disabled bay should be provided at Heffer Close. Vehicle tracking has been undertaken to ensure that HGVs had adequate room to safely manoeuvre from the entrance of Travis Perkins. The dedicated parking bay presently serves the local shop and the TRO has been amended to ensure that no parking is permitted between the hours of 8am -9am and 3pm – 4pm to ensure additional safety for children cycling to school. No further requirement for double yellow lines or disabled bay has been demonstrated.

	The waiting restrictions will improve visibility and safety for cyclists, pedestrians and equestrian users.
