Details of decision taken	After a review of the details of the proposed scheme, the Interim Director of GCP, in conjunction with Councillors Damary-Homan and Fane, decided that the proposals should be implemented as published.
Reasons for taking decision	• No responses were received to the TRO proposal. • The waiting restrictions will prevent the exit/entrance of the upgraded DNA path from being blocked by vehicles, creating a safer environment for walking, cycling and wheeling.
