Title of decision	PR1098 Traffic Regulation Order proposal to implement a 20mph speed limit in Chaston Road, Birch Trees Road, Orchard Road, Grain Close, Wheelers, Macauley Avenue, Meadow View, Macauley Square, Great Shelford.

Details of decision taken	After a review of the details of the proposed scheme, the Interim Director of GCP, in conjunction with Councillors Damary-Homan and Fane, decided that the proposals should be implemented as published. The objector will be informed of the outcome accordingly.
Reasons for taking decision	- One objection was received to the TRO proposal relating to an extension of the 20mph speed limit to include Hinton Way from Orchard Road to the railway station; Station Road to the A1301; and Leeway Avenue and Shelford Park Avenue/Poplar Way. This sits outside of the scope of the scheme and would require further physical measures to ensure that motorists conform to the speed limit. The measures that have been put in place for the route are sufficient to reduce speeds and provide a safer route. 20 mph speed limits have been shown to improve road safety at number of locations. - A 20 mph speed limit will create a safer environment for walking, cycling and wheeling.
