Details of decision taken	After a review of the details of the proposed scheme and taking into account the written representation received, the Service Director of the Greater Cambridge Partnership, in conjunction with Councillor Peter Fane and Councillor Laurence Damary-Homan, decided that the proposals should be implemented as published.
Reasons for taking decision	There were no objections raised to the introduction of a 20mph speed limit in Great Shelford, Abberley Wood, De Freville Road, Granham's Close and the introduction of a 40mph speed limit on Granham's Road. The speed limits will slow traffic down around the crossing from the northern section of the DNA path to the southern section, adjacent to the level crossing on Granham's Road.
