



Milton Road - Bus, Cycling and Walking Improvements Project December 2022 Update

Arrangements over the Christmas and New Year Holiday

The Milton Road project will shut down from 23 December to 6 January 2023 for the Christmas and New Year Holiday.

Work areas will be made safe and secure with access for residents being maintained. The 24/7 phone line (0800 023 4762) will be in operation throughout the festive period should you need to speak to anyone. There will also be regular inspections by Milestone through the holidays.

Elizabeth Way Roundabout

We continue to make progress at the new Elizabeth Way roundabout, with the new kerb line, drainage and tarmac having been recently installed. When complete, the new roundabout will have three additional pedestrian crossings, to enable quicker and safer movements across all four arms of the roundabout. The roundabout will also see a new cycle crossing on each arm, alongside more trees and plants to improve the roundabout and surrounding area. Cambridge Water

Cambridge Water's works are also progressing well. They have now finished their water diversion between Mitcham's Corner to Gilbert Road and are now working at Ascham Road in order to carry out further water diversions. Cambridge Water will also stop works for the Christmas shutdown and will recommence in the New Year. Union Lane

Works on Union Lane to redesign the junction are continuing. During the site closure over Christmas and New Year holidays, Union Lane will be re-opened for motor vehicle access. The road will then be closed once more when the site re-opens on the 5 January 2023 to allow us to finish the work on upgrading this part of the junction.



Kings Hedges

Works to the Kings Hedges, Milton Road, Green End Road junction will start early in the New Year. Similarly, to the Union Lane works, the new junction will be constructed in sections. We estimate works will last around 10 months and will be carried out Monday – Friday between 07:30 – 18:00.

So we can do the work to upgrade this junction safely, we will be replacing the current traffic lights with temporary traffic lights. This will give the flexibility to be able to move the lights around as we work on different part of this junction. Having tested one style of temporary traffic lights earlier this year, we have changed the system we will be using at this junction for works in the New Year. The temporary
