Cambourne to Cambridge – Environmental Impact Assessment Public Consultation

The Cambourne to Cambridge (C2C) Better Public Transport Project is a proposed public transport link to connect growing communities between Cambourne and Cambridge and a new Travel Hub facility at Scotland Farm, off the A428 - with a new active travel route to make cycling and walking easier and safer.

Following public consultations and extensive technical work to determine a preferred route, (all of which can be viewed at the GCP web pages <u>www.greatercambridge.org.uk/CambournetoCambridge</u>) we're now undertaking an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA). To inform the EIA, a public consultation will run from Monday 16 May until Monday 11 July.
