I am appalled by the proposed transport proposals planned for Cambourne-Cambridge transport proposals:

- very poor utilisation of embedded carbon within the pavements/roadway.
- removal of vast quantities of biomass & carbon sequestering bio-infrastructure
- very poor cost benefit analysis where £ unit of account...even worse using Green House Gas equivalent as unit of account.
