Linton Greenway Active Travel Path - Hinton Way to Haverhill Road

The Greater Cambridge Partnership and contractors Milestone Infrastructure are currently working to improve the Linton Greenway, from Hinton Way Roundabout to the Babraham Road Park and Ride Junction. The works to this section of the Greenway are progressing well with road marking complete and traffic signals commissioning underway.

From April 25th the Linton Greenway improvement works will continue along the A1307, from the Hinton Way Roundabout towards Haverhill Road. This part of the works is scheduled to be completed within 6 weeks.

These works will be carried out under local, temporary traffic and pedestrian management to ensure a safe route for active travel path users.

The Hinton Way roundabout is due to be resurfaced later in May. The resurfacing works and associated road marking works will require overnight closure of the roundabout. Exact dates for this work will be confirmed once they are agreed with the Cambridgeshire County Council's Streetworks Team.

We do apologise for any inconvenience these works and closures may cause. We are working closely with our contractors to minimise disruption.
