A1307 Cambridge South East Transport Phase 1



Linton Greenway Active Travel Path – works at Linton Village College, The Meadow, and A1307 Junction

The Greater Cambridge Partnership and contractors Milestone will be starting work to improve the active travel path at the Linton Village College along the A1307 from 25 July. To minimise disruption the works are planned to take place during the summer break weeks and be complete in time for the start of the new Linton Village College term in September.

What works will be done?

- Improvements to the existing active travel path along the A1307 and at the Linton Village College Junction. Improvement will also be undertaken to the existing pathway at the Meadow with new bollards installed.
- Localised widening, realignment and resurfacing of the existing active travel path.
- Removing the existing pedestrian barrier and realignment of the existing central traffic island at the Linton Village College Junction.
- Relocation of existing street lighting and signage to facilitate the active pathway improvements.
- Upgrading the pedestrian crossing and traffic signals at the Linton Village College Junction.
- Improved signage and road markings.

Traffic management on A1307 during construction

Traffic management on the A1307 will comprise of:

- Temporary 30mph speed restriction when traffic management is in place.
- During certain phases of the works, temporary 3-way traffic lights will be required during off-peak hours (9.30 am to 3.30 pm).
- Access and egress to the Linton Village College and Community Sports Centre site will be always maintained.

How will the works affect active travel path users?

Throughout the works, a safe route for active travel path users will always be maintained.

During times when works are being undertaken along the active travel path, as necessary, the users will be escorted past the works area.

Whilst temporary lights are in use on the A1307, pedestrians / cyclists will be diverted via the closed section of the A1307 main carriageway.

We would like to apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause. However, these works will improve road safety for all road users at this location of the A1307.
