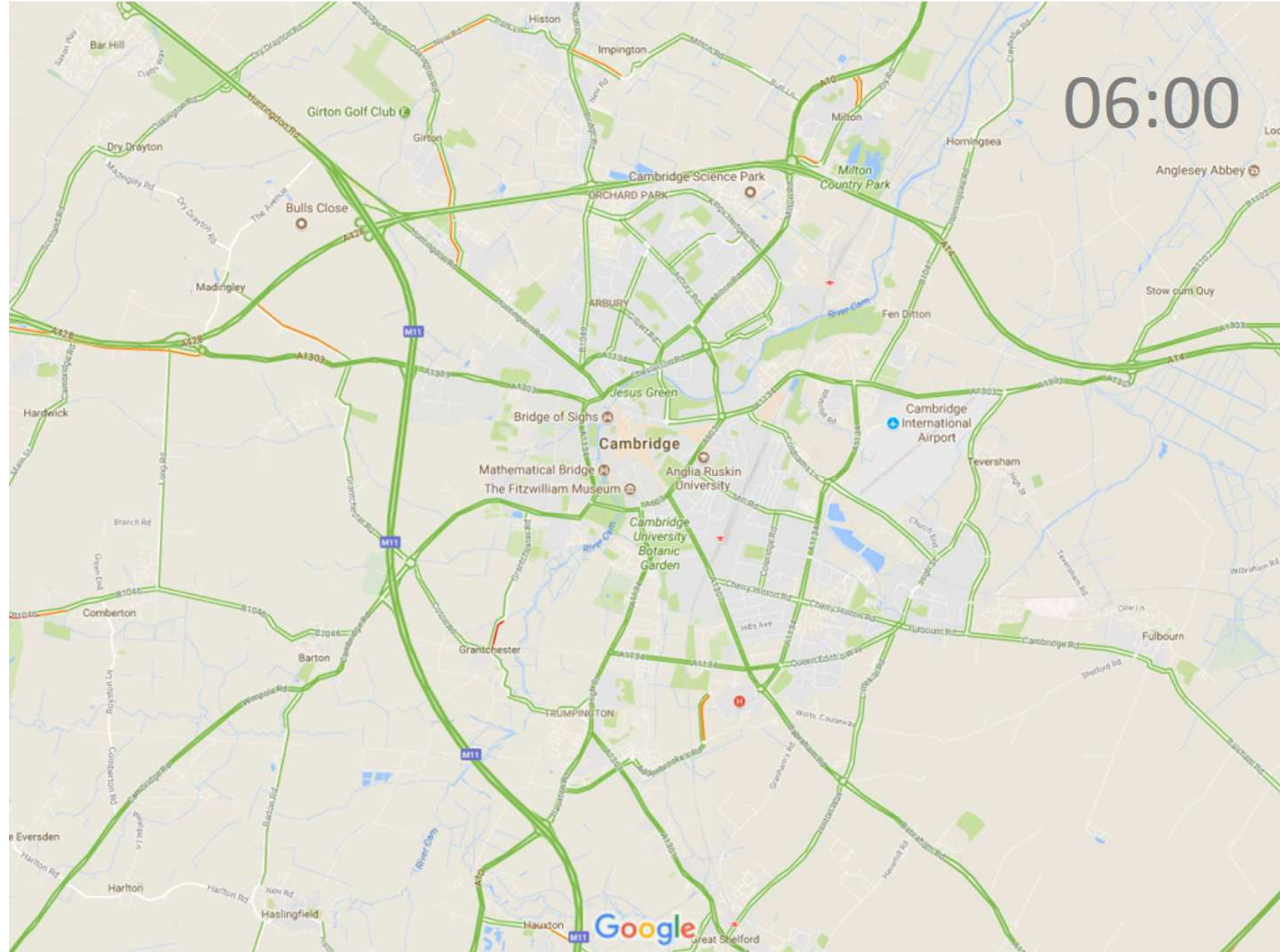

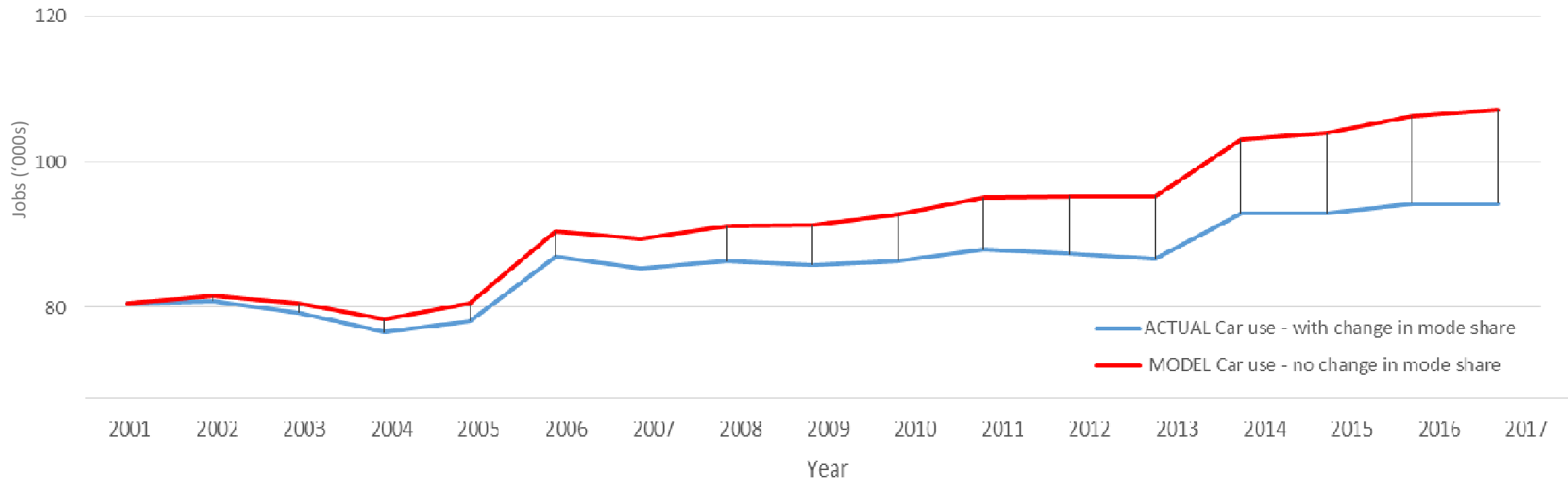

Congestion in Cambridge is a problem

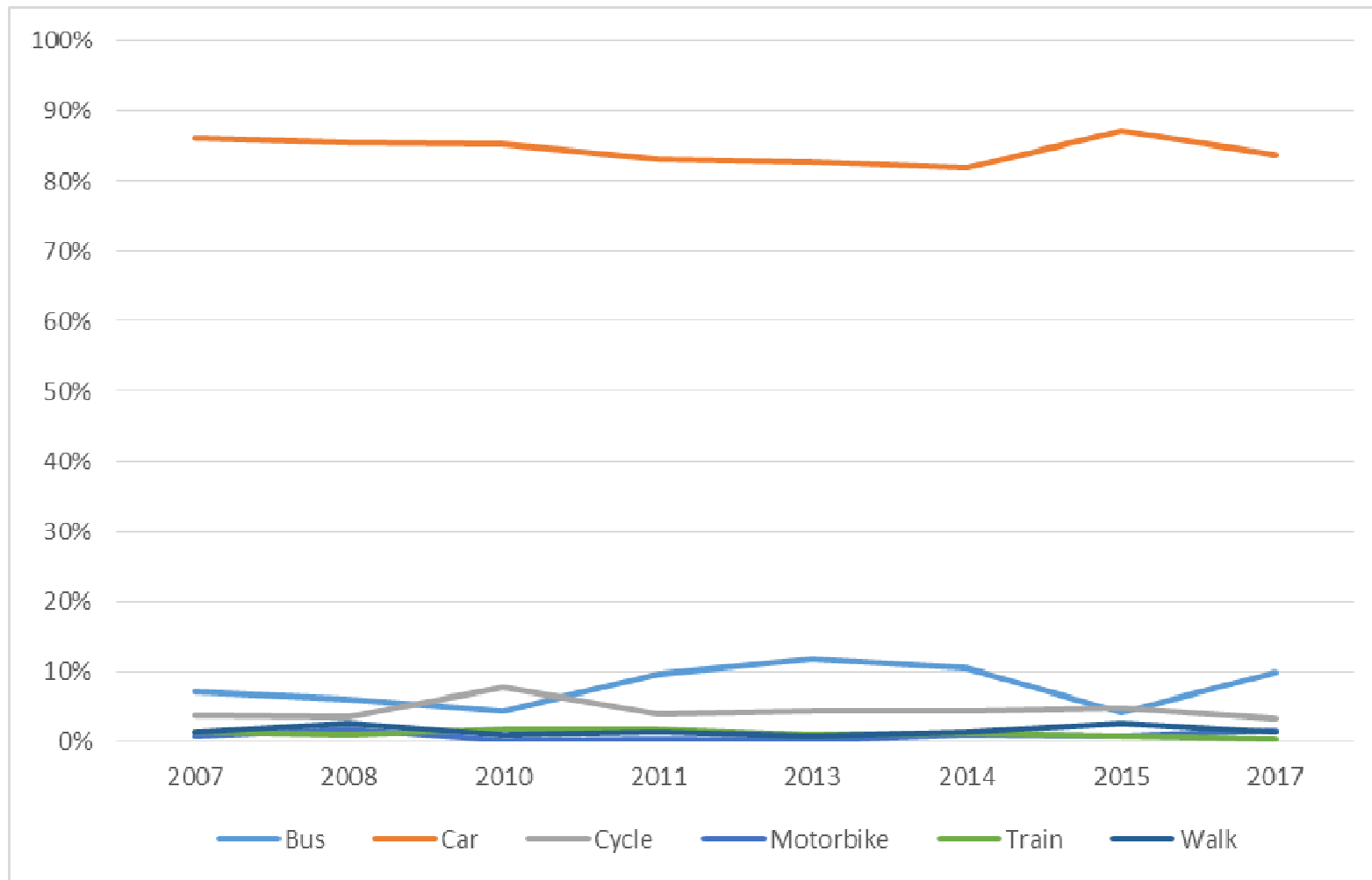

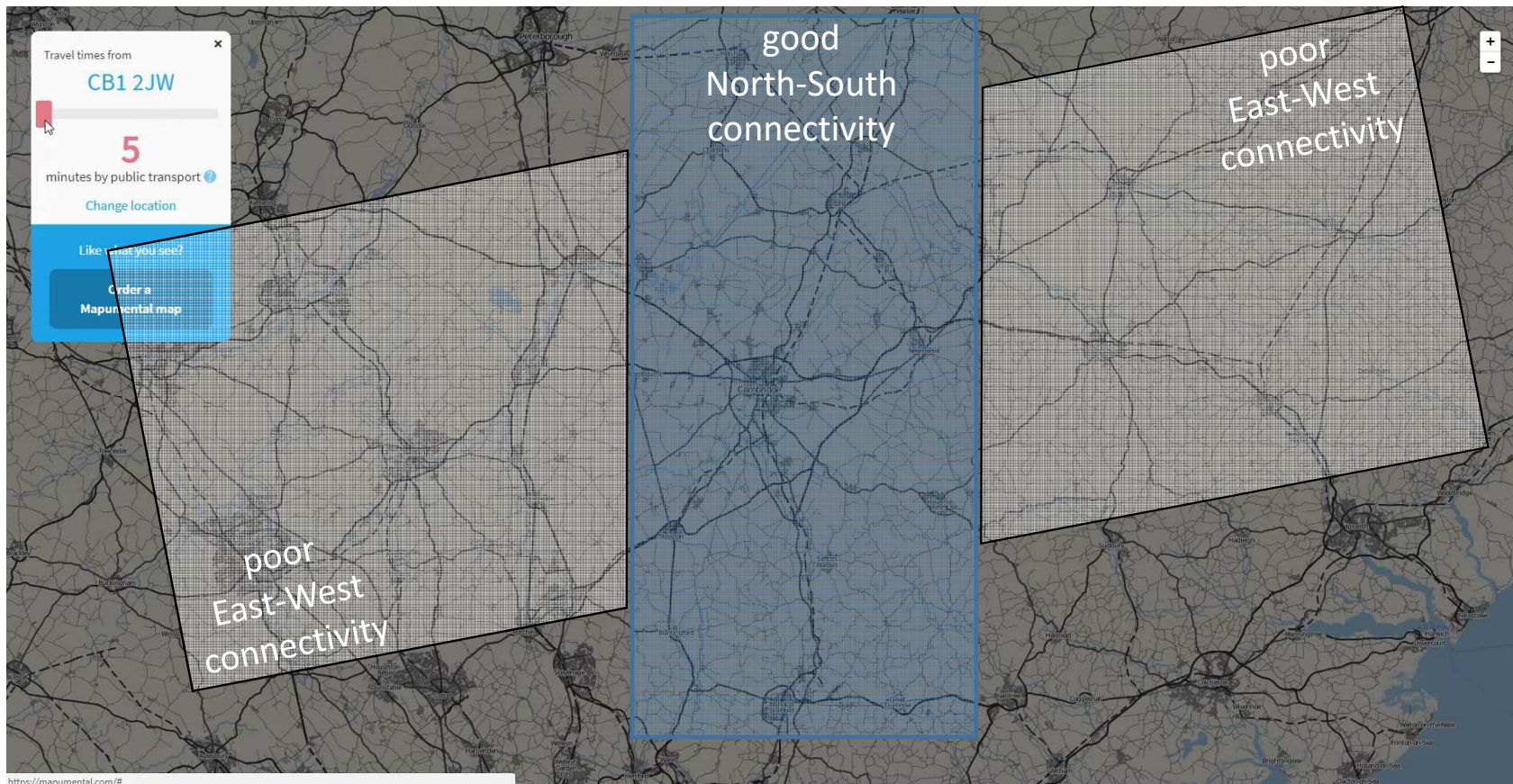
People are slowly moving away from car commuting – in some places



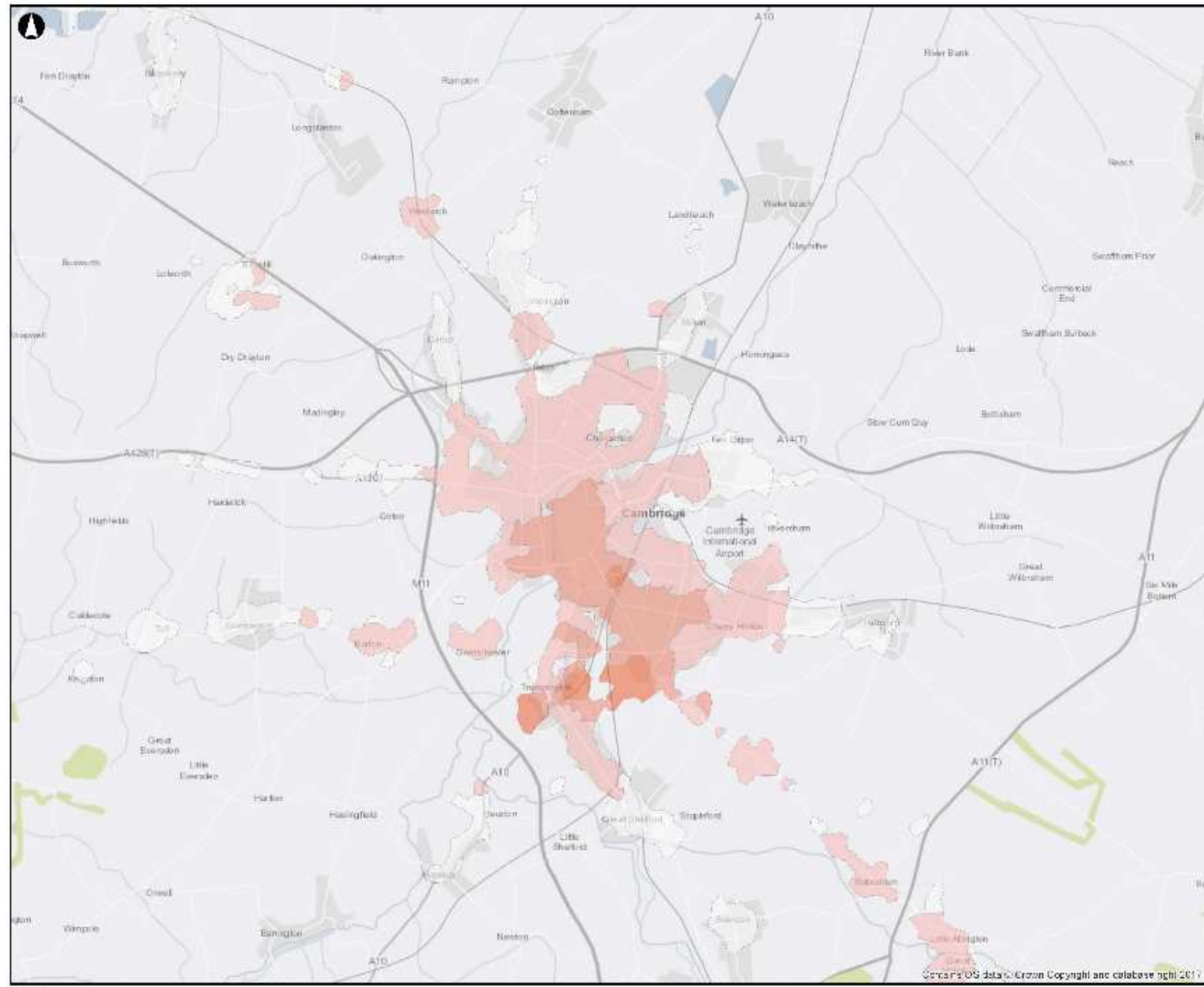
... but not in others



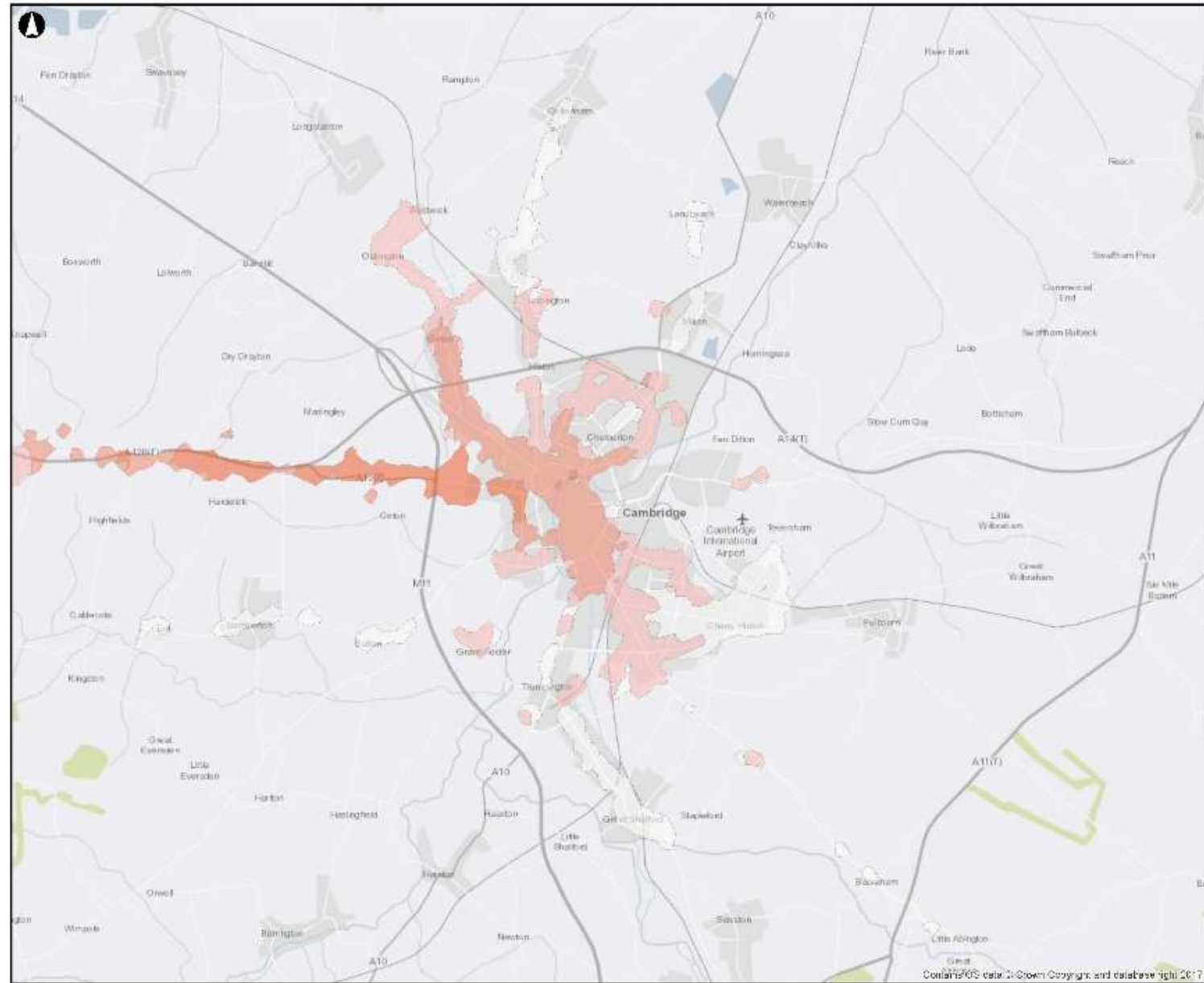
You can't get very far in an hour on public transport
